




BCP SHIPMENT BY END-USE, 2025 ESTIMATE (2)




HIGHLIGHTS

Arauco generates renewable energy from forestry biomass and uses it in the production processes.

In Chile, Argentina and Uruguay, we are self-sufficient in net electricity consumption and we sell the surplus to the local grid.

5 cogeneration plants in Chile and 1 plant in Uruguay are registered under the Kyoto Protocol Clean Development Mechanism (CDM).





ARAUCO Invests in Satellite Technology to Protect Biodiversity

In 2023, ARAUCO's startup, Lemu, achieved a groundbreaking milestone by launching the world's first private nanosatellite dedicated to biodiversity monitoring.

- The satellite is shoebox-sized and equipped with a high-definition hyperspectral camera.
- It delivers 20 times greater precision than current methods.
- It will monitor:
 - Andean wetlands
 - Macroalgae forests
 - Land-use changes

The mission aims to revolutionize biodiversity tracking, detect environmental shifts, and support global conservation efforts.



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
